Proof of Benefit Letters

Parents/guardians who are currently in receipt of the below benefits, will need to upload a Proof of Benefit Letter, along with their application. Applicants can request this by visiting [this website](#). We ask that you remind your parent community of this requirement, as an application cannot be processed until we receive all supporting documentation for the applicant.

- * Income Support;
- * Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- * Income Related Employment and Support Allowance;
- * Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit.
